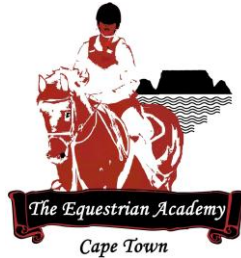
Cultural & Enrichment Programme:

Compulsory 1 hour lesson Fridays 1.30 – 2.30pm; Fees are additional and will depend on the activity chosen by the student termly. Each term students select one of the activities from a list of the most popular from a range of activities.

Our schools co-curricular cultural and enrichment programme is aimed at developing the “whole” child and it is our intention to focus on a holistic approach in this development. Students are given the opportunity to showcase further talents and may even participate in and study these activities formally while enrolling for examinations, eisteddfods, etc. Some examples of activities include: art, drama, dance, debating, photography, IT (Computer studies – webdesign, software, etc) music instrument i.e. drum kit, guitar, etc., pilates, foreign languages i.e. Portuguese, Spanish, French, etc, chess and more.

Boarding Fees:

- Monthly: R5,710 x 12 months (Girls) & R6,710 x 12 months (Boys) for full-time **termly boarding**. Once off Total R65,780 (Girls), Total R77,300 (Boys) for four terms boarding.
- Annual Payment: Annual discount of 4% will be granted in the event of the full fees for the year being paid on or before the 7th January.
- A non-refundable **deposit of one month's boarding fees** is payable on Acceptance of Place for boarding. This amount will be credited to the first month of the term once the pupil is in the boarding house facility.
- Payment terms: all payments are strictly in advance
- Annual: 1 Payment by 7 January
Monthly: 12 x equal payments/installments on the 1st of each month by EFT payment
Exception: for Grade 12 students whose fees are paid in 11 equal payments from the 1st of January until 1st November.
- The boarding fees entitle the pupil to full use of the boarding house facilities and meals during school terms. **No rebate will be given in the event of the pupil not making full use of the above. No credits will be given what-so-ever. Only a full term's notice will apply on complete withdrawal from the boarding house.**
- Other charges such as transport, telephone, laundry (laundry charged at R162/week for washing, drying & ironing 2 days/week), boarding house outings, medication, etc. will be charged to student's school accounts.
- **One term's notice**, in writing, is required when withdrawing a learner from the EACT Boarding House. A term's notice will be charged to accounts on immediate withdrawal from the Boarding House.
- A **R250 key deposit** is charged to each Boarder which shall be refunded on the final exit from EACT Boarding House.
- A **R500 Boarding Breakages Deposit** will be charged to each Boarder's account which shall be retained as a deposit on any costs should a Boarder brake or damage anything in the Boarding House. Should the repairs to damaged or broken EACT property exceed R500 the Boarder will be liable for the balance of the repair costs. The R500 Boarding Deposit shall be refunded should there be no damages/breakages on final exit of the Boarder.

I.T. Equipment –

- **All EACT students are required to have a PC tablet** which shall be used daily in the classrooms for lessons and lectures. Software that should be installed: Microsoft Office.
- **PC Tablet with etextbooks loaded:** EACT High School is joining the eRevolution! As from January 2014 all class textbooks will only be available as ebooks and used in the classrooms from January 2014. Recommended tablets must be purchased by parents from IT stores and EACT High School IT Technician will load students' etextbooks (which is purchased from the school) onto their tablets.

General Terms & Conditions:

- Tuition Fees exclude: IEB exam fees and other exam fees. eTextbooks are additional to fees.
- Monthly tuition fees are paid in 12 equal payments on the 1st day of each month from 1st January until 1st December except for Grade 12 students whose fees are paid in 11 equal payments from the 1st of January until 1st November.



- The Application and Registration/Acceptance fee is non-refundable.
- The school reserves the right to restrict admission of any pupil in respect of whom monies to the school are outstanding.
- The school reserves the right to withhold student school reports and exam results whose school accounts are not paid up at the end of school terms.
- The school reserves the right to restrict a matric student from writing the matric examinations whose exam fees and school accounts are not paid up.
- **One term's notice**, in writing, is required when withdrawing a learner from the School. A term's notice will be charged to accounts on immediate withdrawal.
- All payments received will be applied firstly to the reduction of interest, legal fees and fees in lieu of notice, sundry charges and arrears applicable and then to the reduction of current tuition fees.
- In the case of a parent, guardian, or person responsible for the payment of fees being sequestrated and there are arrears fees, the student's attendance at the school will be immediately suspended. The students continued attendance will be subject to all fees being paid in advance.
- Sundry charges that will be charged: photocopying, outings, enrichment & cultural lessons, printing, telephone calls, laundry and certain activities where outside facilitators are paid to do presentations, etc.
- Although school management will always endeavour not to increase tuition fees during the school year, it reserves the right to do so if circumstances require it. Increases in fees can reasonably be expected each year to provide for inflation and other costs.
- Late **payment charge** will be levied at the rate of 15% on all accounts not settled by due date. Annual fees not paid in full by the 7th January and monthly fees not paid by the 1st day each month will be regarded as overdue.
- Non-payment of school account shall entitle the Director to cancel the enrolment of the pupil forthwith. Should a cheque/debit order be returned by the bank, a surcharge of R250.00 will apply.
- EACT High School is a "**cash free**" zone, parents are kindly requested not to pay fees in this manner. **We reserve the right to recover cash deposit fees incurred.**
- The Director may in her sole discretion grant refunds and make changes or adjustments of fees and other charges and shall give one term's written notice thereof.
- The Director shall be entitled to instruct the academy's attorneys to attend to the collection of outstanding accounts and both parents (whether natural, adoptive or foster parents) shall be jointly and severally liable for the payment of all costs so incurred, on the scale as between attorney and own client, including collection fees.
